Are you a UK taxpayer? If so you'll be helping to support the Farmland Museum, since, as a charity we will claim Gift Aid on your admission, at no additional cost to you.

For every £1 you give or pay means £1.25 to help us to fund museum projects. This means that £6 becomes £7.50 or £15 becomes £18.25 as long as payment is made by Gift Aid.

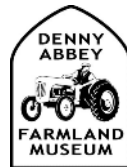
All you need to do is sign below.

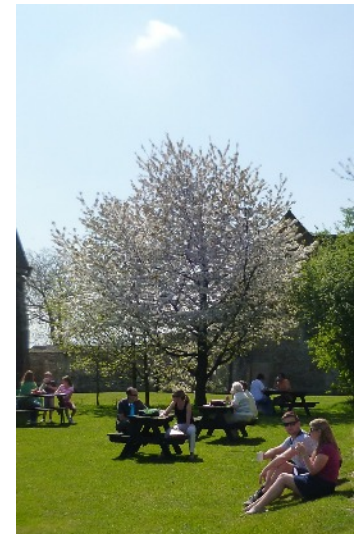
